Programmatic Accomplishments

In the 2002-03 school year, Homewaters Project:

Partnered with Seattle Public Schools, Seattle Public Utilities and Seattle Parks to implement field investigations for the Land and Water Science Unit.

Set up collaborative relationship with WWU's Urban Center to connect aspiring teachers to inquiry-based field experiences.

Developed and implemented Tiny Neighbors teacher training with Seattle Schools and assisted with field investigations.

Created NSCC Green Maps with college students.

Collaborated with Washington Audubon Society, on Community Mapping programs with Washington Middle School and the African American Academy.

Initiated a Graffiti Mapping Program with the Lake City Task Force.

Developed an Exploring Local History curriculum for middle school students.

Organized and led two Thornton Creek Long Walks with community members.

Assisted Parkwood and Lake Forest Park Elementary Schools with long-term applied learning projects.
